



COMPETITION: *Research Prize “MOISA”*

Art. 1 - For the occasion of the Sixth Annual Meeting of MOISA International Society for the Study of Greek and Roman Music and its Cultural Heritage, to be held at Agrigento from May 14–16 2013, the Fondazione AGireinsieme has established the scholarly prize “MOISA”.

The prize will be awarded to the best MA or PhD thesis dedicated to Greek and Roman music and its cultural heritage, in any of its aspects—archaeological, iconographical, philological-literary, theoretical, art historical, religio-historical or anthropological.

Art. 2 - The competition is open to anyone who has defended an MA or PhD thesis, in Italian or English, no more than two calendar years prior to the competition deadline (see article 4 below). Theses which have already received a comparable award are excluded from the competition.

Art. 3 - The award of 1000.00 Euros, provided by the Fondazione AGireinsieme, will also include a visit to the archaeological excavations sponsored by the Fondazione, in collaboration with the Parco Archeologico della Valle dei Templi, in the area of ancient *Akragas*.

Art. 4 - Applications for the competition, to be made using form A (attached below), must be addressed to the President of the Fondazione AGireinsieme and sent in PDF format to segreteria@fondazioneagireinsieme.it and copied to angelabella1@virgilio.it and angelamaria.bellia2@unibo.it. Applications received later than March 1, 2013 at 1 p.m., for whatever reason, will not be considered.

In their applications competitors must state:

- for the purposes of the competition, name, address, telephone number and email address;
- their nationality;
- that they have not received comparable recognition for the same work.

Competitors must include with their applications:

- a PDF copy of a valid form of identification
- a PDF copy of the MA or PhD thesis in Italian or English

Art. 5 - The jury for the prize will consist of the President of MOISA and by two university-level instructors/researchers nominated by him. The Fondazione AGireinsieme will also designate a representative their own. The committee can distribute the prize equally between candidates who are considered of equal merit.

Art. 6 - The award ceremony will take place during the Sixth Meeting of MOISA International Society for the Study of Greek and Roman Music and its Cultural Heritage (Agrigento, May 14–16, 2013).
